



Reconciliation Dance Studio Payment Agreement

The Payment Policies are as follows:

- ◆ Payments each month are **due at the end of the month** (or the last class meeting that month) for the following month's instruction. All payments must be received by the studio no later than the 30th or 31st or the 28th/29th (for February) in order to avoid the late fees.
- ◆ If you/your child is unable to make it to the last class of the month, and therefore unable to pay tuition on the due date, notice must be given to the owner via phone or email and the payment mailed in order to avoid the late fees.
- ◆ Late fees will be charged for each week the tuition payment is late. These fees will be as follows: **One week** after the due date—\$10*, **Two weeks**—\$20*, and **Three weeks**—**the tuition amount***. *These fees are in addition to the tuition payment. For any additional days after three weeks, the late fee will be determined by RDS's owner.
- ◆ For holidays, the tuition is still due by the end of the month. The late fees will still apply for any and all payments that are late.
- ◆ Checks, made payable to *Reconciliation Dance Studio*, or cash are the only forms of payment accepted at the studio.
- ◆ A fee of \$20 will be charged for any returned check. This fee is in addition to any late fees, if applicable.
- ◆ Parents/guardians with more than one child enrolled in dance classes will receive a discount for each additional child.
